



## TECHNICAL RIDER

“John Singer Sargent: Painting Madame X” is a self-contained traveling theatrical production and, as such, requires no props, furnishings or special equipment from the hosting organization or venue. The performance does, however, request the following of the presenting venue/organization. Please review this information carefully now to assure a quality presentation.

**STAGE ACCESS:** There must be stage-level access to accommodate road “boxes” up to 3ft x 5ft -- no stairs or elevators.

**SET-UP TIME:** There must be access to the performance space at least 3 hours before the audience will be entering the space.

**STAFF AVAILABILITY:** A qualified technician or authorized employee/volunteer must be available during set-up to work out any technical issues.

**STAGE/PERFORMANCE SPACE:** If you don't have a traditional stage, you will need to provide an acting space, preferably at least 20 x 20, with basic lighting and access to electricity (visit [www.PaintingMadameX.com](http://www.PaintingMadameX.com) for stage layouts). The staging of this show does not allow “in the round” presentation. A “dressing” room should be near the performance area.

**ELECTRICITY:** The show requires a standard electrical outlet near the performance space which will remain “hot” throughout the set-up and performance.

**LIGHTING:** Though “theater” lighting is not an absolute requirement, it will be necessary to be able to darken the room just prior to the beginning of the show, and darken it again at the show's close. The presenter must provide a person to perform this function. If “theater” lighting is available, a qualified lighting technician must be available during set-up and performance.

There are no sound cues and no set or costume changes during the show. The actual theatrical performance runs 40 minutes, and is immediately followed by a discussion led by the performer/ playwright.

**ADDITIONAL PRESENTATIONS:** Painting demonstrations, informal lectures and discussions are also available through prior arrangement.

**SUPPORT MATERIALS:** Your hosting of this show will be fully supported with professional graphics, photos and copy for your use in promoting the event.
